LAFCO will hold the Protest Hearing for the City of Santa Clarita Annexation No. 2002-09A, on Wednesday, June 28, 2006, at 9:00 a.m., in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room (Room 381 B), Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012. Written protests against the City of Santa Clarita Annexation No. 2002-09A may be filed beginning on March 30, 2006, the date of publication of the Notice of Public Hearing and thereafter, to the conclusion of the Protest Hearing. ***Only written protests signed and dated on or after March 30, 2006, and received before the conclusion of the Protest Hearing, will be counted toward the protest.***

For the purposes of ascertaining written protests pursuant to Government Code Section 57075.5, if inhabited territory is proposed to be annexed to a city with **more than** 100,000 residents, the Commission shall: (a) terminate proceedings if written protests have been filed and not withdrawn by 50 percent or more of the registered voters within the affected territory; (b) order the territory annexed subject to confirmation by special election within the affected territory if written protests have been filed and not withdrawn by either 15 percent or more of the registered voters or 15 percent or more of the number of landowners owning who also own not less than 15 percent of the total assessed value of land within the affected territory; or (c) order the territory annexed if written protests have been filed and not withdrawn by less than 15 percent of the registered voters and landowners who own less than 15 percent of the total assessed value of land within the affected territory.
