NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CITY OF LONG BEACH REORGANIZATION NO. 2011-13

Pursuant to Section 56157 of the Government Code, the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles is required to notify all registered voters and owners of property within the subject territory, and within 300 feet of the exterior boundary of a property subject to annexation proceedings.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to Government Code Section 56154, of the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles will hold a public hearing to consider the reorganization of uninhabited, unincorporated territory to the City of Long Beach, consisting of four separate areas totaling approximately 72.53 acres.

Purpose of the Request: The proposal is in conjunction with a boundary adjustment between Los Angeles County and Orange County.

Location: The affected territory is generally located along the south and southeast boundary line of the City of Long Beach and the boundaries of the Cities of Seal Beach and Los Alamitos, along the Los Angeles County and Orange County limits.

The hearing will be held on Wednesday, at 9:00 a.m., on the 9th day of November 2011, in the Board of Supervisors hearing room (Room 381 B), Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, California. Interested persons may present testimony at said hearing and/or may submit comments by mail. Written correspondence must be filed with the Executive Officer prior to the conclusion of this hearing.
